June 26 (Day 1) Friday

Before the break, you were given homework regarding two contrasting theories given by two anthropologists about the origin of the Filipino people.

1. In your opinion, which theory is more logical? Give at least two reasons why the theory you chose seems to be more logical.
2. Write your thoughts on this matter in your journal notebook. Mark this journal entry with the heading **Civics and History 5 Journal 1.1**. Remember to write in script.

June 29 (Day 2) Monday

Prehistory (before written history) is often divided into two stages or periods; the **Stone Age** and the **Age of Metals**. Many believe that the people who lived during the Age of Metals were more advanced than those who lived during the Stone Age.

1. Using a **before and after format**, draw and color two sets of pictures depicting scenes of how things were done during the Stone Age and how these were done with the dawn of the Age of Metals.
2. The “before” stage is the Stone Age and the “after” stage is the Age of Metals. Draw these pictures on a short bond paper. Don’t forget to write your name and section.

June 30 (Day 3) Tuesday

The early Filipinos traded with other countries before the arrival of the Spaniards. They traded with China, Japan, Arabia, and India to name a few.

1. Using old magazines, newspapers or downloaded images from the Internet, cut out at least four pictures of items which were brought to the Philippine Islands by traders from these countries.
2. Post these images on a foldable (any type will do). Use bright colored paper for the foldable. Write the headings China, Japan, Arabia, and India respectively for the items which came from each country.
3. The cover page of the foldable should bear the title “Our Trading Partners”. Write your name and section too on the cover page.

July 1 (Day 4) Wednesday

In your textbook, read about the life of the early Filipinos. Take note of the structure of society, their religion, and their customs and traditions.

In your Civics and History notebook, answer the following questions:

1. Which customs and traditions of early Filipinos are still observable in today's society? Enumerate at least five.
2. Describe how these five traditions or customs are practiced in present day Philippine society.
