

## EARTH'S PROFILE

**Objective: This activity aims to :**

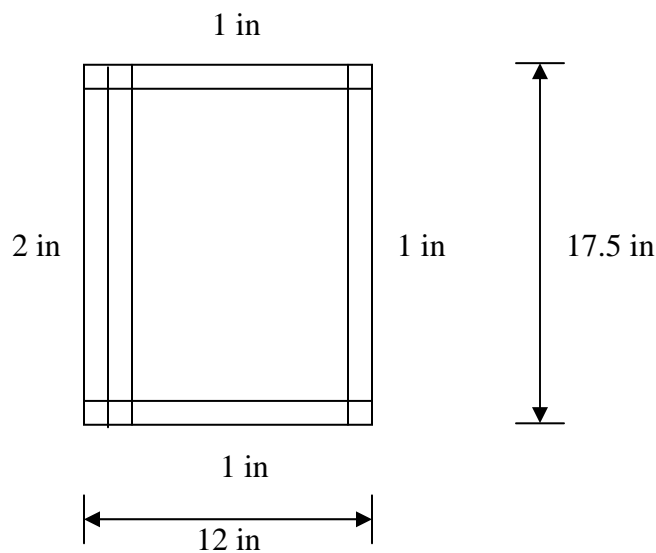
- facilitate the student's understanding of the Earth.
- help assess student's ideas about the Earth and its characteristics
- enhance the student's artistic ability through the construction of a simple portfolio.

**Materials:**

1 Whole Manila Paper      A Pair of Scissors      Colored Papers  
Coloring Materials      Glue      Ruler      Pencil  
Pictures about the Earth (You're allowed to surf the net for other pictures about the Earth.)

**Procedure:**

1. Read the procedures first before performing the activity.
2. Gather the materials that you'll be needing for this activity. You are allowed to use other materials that are not listed if they are not available.
3. Once you have all materials, you may proceed to the next step.
4. Fold the Manila paper into 8 equal parts (17.5 in. x 12 in.)
5. After folding the paper, use a pair of scissors to cut the folded parts. There are now 8 small sheets.
6. Using a ruler and pencil, place margins on each sheet:



7. Take the 7 pieces of the cut Manila paper and label the top of each paper as follows:

1. Earth as Part of the Universe
2. Earth and its Satellite
3. Earth and its Four Layers
4. Earth and the Different Time Zones
5. Earth and its Unique Atmosphere
6. Earth and its Weather
7. Earth and its Ocean

*(NOTE: You are allowed to use the computer to type and print out the title of each paper. You may also use coloring materials and colored papers for the titles.)*

8. Take the last piece of Manila paper. On the middle of the page, write an appropriate title for the portfolio. *(NOTE: You are allowed to use the computer to type and print out the title of the portfolio. You may also use coloring materials and colored papers for the title. Design your own cover page.)*

9. Each page of your portfolio should have at least 8 pictures that tell about what that page is about. Put a caption or title under each picture. *(NOTE: If will search the net for pictures, the dimension of the pictures should be at least 3in x 3 in.)*

10. Write a one-paragraph description of what the page is about. Minimum of 200 words. *(NOTE: If you're going to use the computer, the font style should be Times New Roman and the font size should be 12.)*

11. Arrange your portfolio as follows:

- 1) Title page
- 2) See procedure #7 for the arrangement of the other pages of the portfolio.

12. Assemble the pages of your portfolio with glue. Glue them together on the first 1 inch (found at the left most of each page) of the 2-inch margin.

13. You are allowed to design your portfolio.

14. Write your name on the very last page of the portfolio.
